



Eucharistic Miracle Bordeaux, France 1822 Activity


1. Make a copy of the Bordeaux Monstrance on plain copy paper. One for every child.




2. Make a copy of the image of Jesus on cardstock. One to every four or five children. This will be reusable.



3. Using a thin line of white glue or slick fabric paint, carefully trace over the outline of the image of Jesus. (I used fabric paint since the paint opening was narrow.) Let the image completely dry.





- 4. Place the Monstrance over the image of Jesus and line up all edges.
- 5. Lightly rub a crayon over the Eucharist to have the image of Jesus appear.

6. Using a red crayon, color in the scarf draped over Jesus' shoulder.
