Materials Needed:

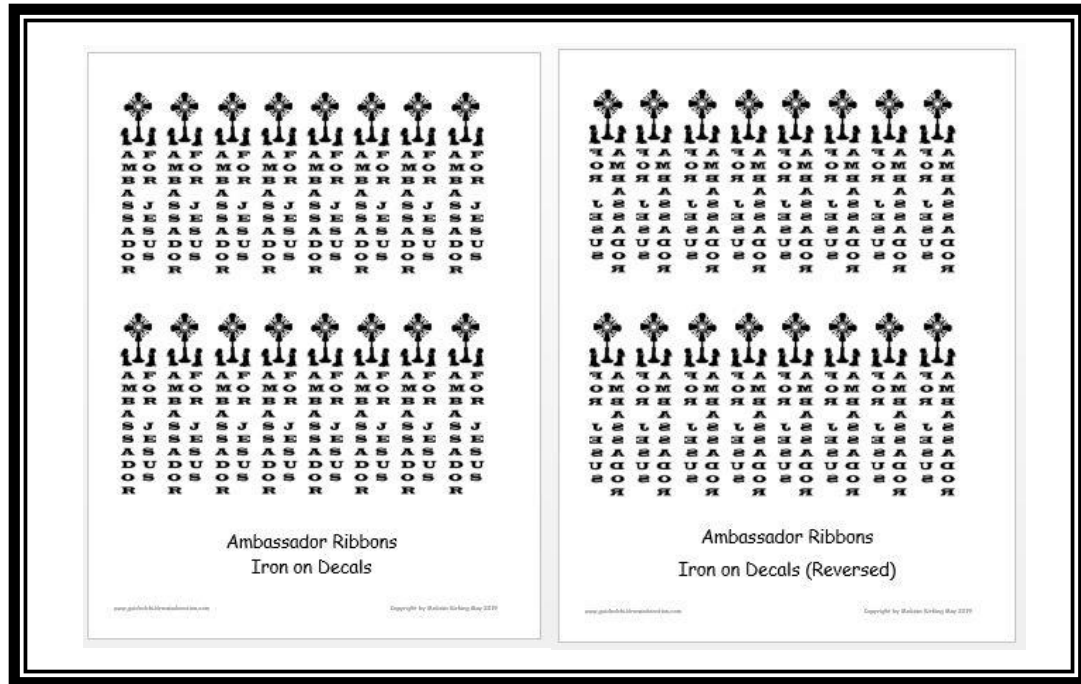
- 5/8 inch Ribbon or Felt cut into 5/8 inch wide strips
- Black Felt
- Adhesive Bar Pins
- Fabric Glue
- Iron on Print Transfer Sheets
- Clothes Pins



Directions:

1. Print the appropriate transfer sheets.

Use the downloadable: Ambassador Ribbon Iron On for dark color fabric background. Use the downloadable: Ambassador Ribbon Reverse Iron On for light color fabric background.

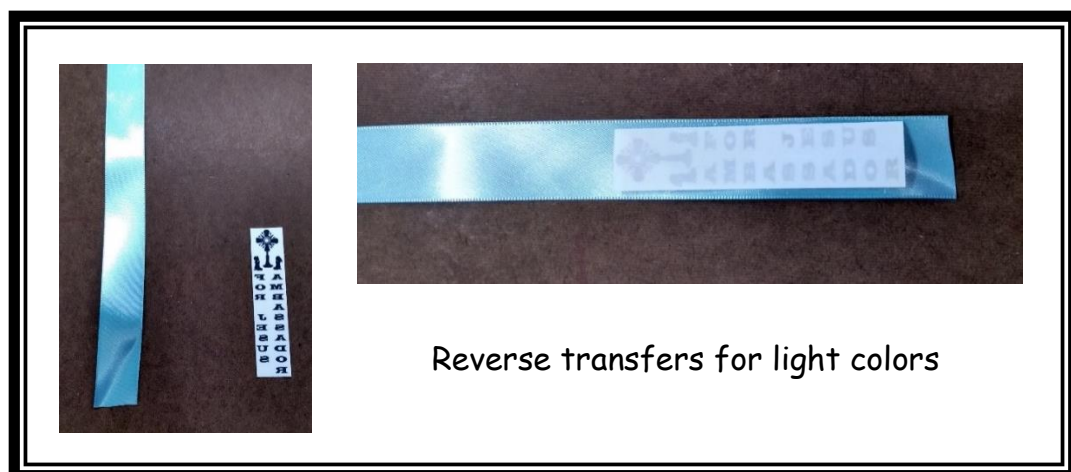


2. Cut the transfers out.

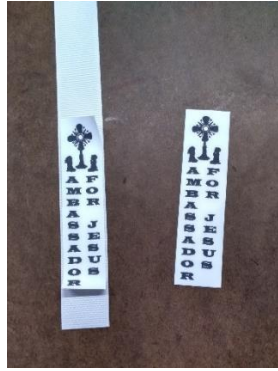
3. Carefully following the package directions, iron the transfers onto the ribbon or felt.

Ribbon should have $\frac{1}{2}$ inch space below the words and $\frac{3}{4}$ inch above the monstrance.

Felt should have $\frac{1}{4}$ inch space below the words and $\frac{1}{2}$ inch above monstrance.



Reverse transfers for light colors



Can use transfers for dark colors on any color fabric. Using dark color transfer paper leaves a white background, not a clear one



It is easier to iron the transfers on a long section of ribbon.

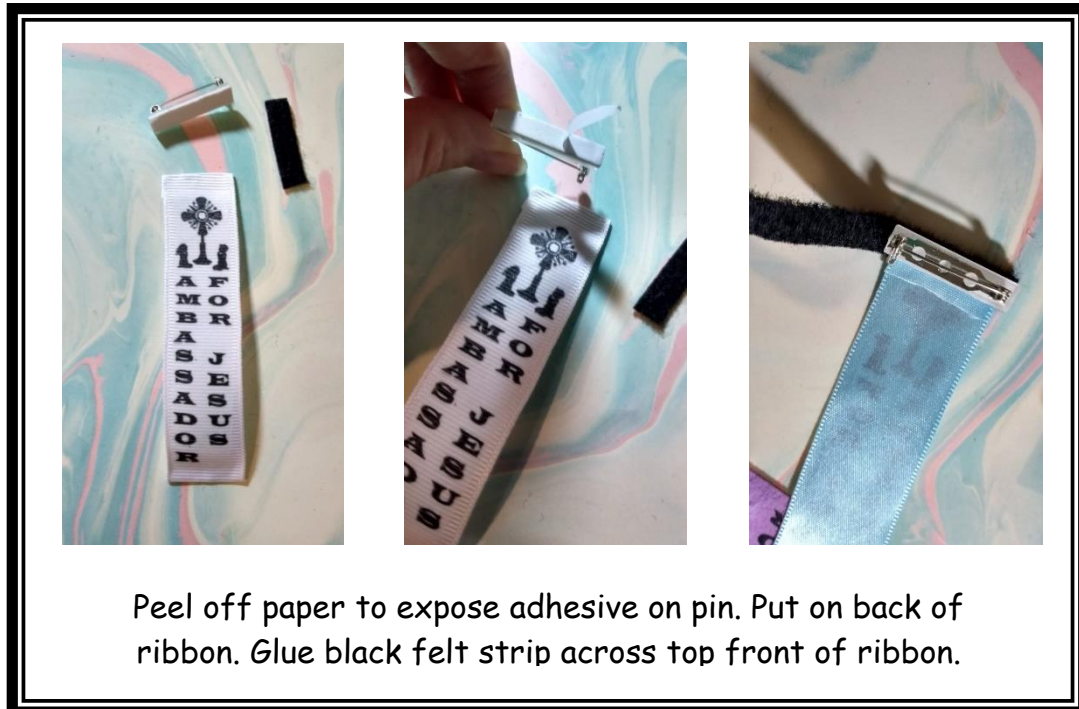
4. Cut the ribbons into individual strips. Using fabric glue on the ribbon's ends, glue under a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch fold and secure till dried with clothes pins. Felt does not fray so there is no need to fold over ends.



5. Cut $\frac{1}{4}$ inch strips of black felt.



6. Assemble the final Ambassador Ribbon
