

The Names of Jesus Activity

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During Adoration we talked and visualized different names of Jesus. (The meditation from Adoration is listed below along with biblical references.) The children can do some of the following activities:

- 1. Discuss what each name means with the children.
- 2. Have the children close their eyes and slowly repeat the list of names. Have the children visualize the image of Jesus that name provokes.
- 3. Pick one of the names to draw an image of Jesus on the bordered paper.
- 4. Repeat the Psalm 34:4 together: "Magnify the Lord with me; let us exalt His name together."

Just as we have nicknames that our loved ones give us, so does Jesus have many names. These names of Jesus are endearments and descriptions of Him. Visualize each name of Jesus as I say it. (Pause between names.)
