

STUDY THE PAINTING, LOOK CLOSELY AT THE DETAILS.

Imagine yourself in the scene. Feel the emotions.

Read John 12:12-13:

On the next day, when the great crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, they took palm branches and went out to meet him, and cried out:

"Hosanna!

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, [even] the king of Israel."

Prayerfully consider:

Jesus entered Jerusalem on Palm Sunday to adoring and cheering crowds. Less than a week later, the crowds in the same town yell, "Crucify Him!"

Talk to Jesus about this:

Why the change?

Do our fickle hearts adore Jesus one moment and turn our back on Him the next?
