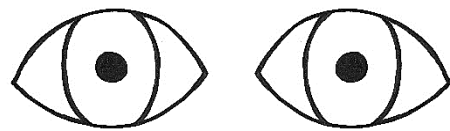

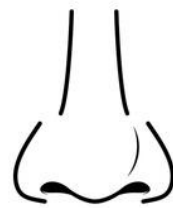

We use our 5 Senses to know things.

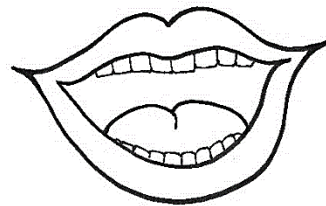

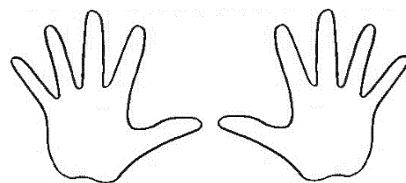

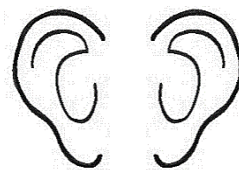
