### Ideas:

Prayers (Our Father, Glory Be, Act of Hope, Act of Love...)

Praise Jesus (Give Jesus glory for just being God, not for what He gives or does for us.)

Thanksgiving

Petitions/intercessions

Be silent and listen to Jesus (Try and put all thoughts out of your head and just be with Jesus) The Rosary

### Younger children:

Using a set of rosary beads, a child can slowly and prayerfully say "I love You, Jesus" on each bead.

Saying, "I love You, Jesus," can also be slowly and prayerfully said as the child puts one finger up till both hands have all their fingers up.


Using their fingers, younger children can thank Jesus for ten things.

Prayer Based Color Sheets

### Parental co-prayer with child:

Using a parent's closed fists, a child can pray 1 decade of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. The child can point to a parent's closed finger each time he says inside his head/heart, "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world." The parent would then raise that finger up. (This would require some practice before entering the chapel.)

Using a parent's closed fists, a child can pray 1 decade of the Rosary in the manner listed above. Prayer Webs: Take turn in different color pens writing/drawing a thanks or a <u>petition</u> in the format below. (From experience, ballpoint pens are quieter than markers.)
