## **What can be expected on a scheduled field trip to the Year C Interactive Eucharistic Miracle Exhibit?**

This is for groups of ten or more coming during regular school hours. There are two tracks available to choose from: **Younger/Elementary Track** and **Older/Middle/High School Track**.

### **Younger/Elementary Field Trip Track:**

- Students will receive a stampable passport and be assigned to one of the [nine newly designed Interactive Eucharistic Miracle Stations](#).
- Approximately every twenty minutes, students will rotate through six of the stations
- At each station, a storyteller will share the Eucharistic Miracle in child friendly language to encourage the children to feel “Eucharistic wonder and awe.”
- Each miracle station will also have a visual display, audience participation play, or interactive display to draw children into the cornerstone of our Catholic faith – Jesus’ True Presence in the Eucharist.
- There will be [all new](#) coordinating activity sheets or projects at each station. These can be done at the station or taken back to school depending on the timing of the individual station.
- There will be a “bring your own” snack break incorporated into the schedule.
- Keeping the age of the children in mind, the miracles in these nine Interactive Eucharistic Miracle Stations are non-blood related so that no child will become worried about the Eucharist turning into blood/flesh when they receive Jesus.

### Older/Middle/High School Field Trip Track:

- Students will gather in the auditorium to listen to a **new presentation**. This presentation is designed to be stand-alone knowledge for first time attendees to marvel at as well.
- Students will explore **thirty-nine (39) new** and five (5) favorites from Blessed Carlos Acutis' *Eucharistic Miracles of the World Exhibit* on large posters.
- **New 2026!** Students will receive 1 or 2 specific miracle information sheet to fill out, thus allowing one class to discover in detail all the miracles in the exhibit. These can then be used for a classroom discussion upon the return to school.
- Students will receive a stampable passport covering these forty-one (44) miracles.
- **Integrated Learning Room 1** will have Year A's microscopes to look at heart tissue, the five interrelated Eucharistic Miracles posters, a beating heart video, and connections between the five interrelated Eucharistic Miracles that have been through extensive scientific study. This is a favorite every year. Students will love the experience!
- **Integrated Learning Room 2** will have a collection of **new activities and displays** such as **St. Carlo Blockhead craft**, paper activity sheets, a **large timeline of Eucharistic events** starting in the Old Testament thru the most recent Eucharistic Miracle, and **much more!**
- **New 2026!** Students can dive deeper into a series of Last Supper paintings by the masters to consider overlapping themes, explanations, and unique characteristics of the people painted in the scene.
- **New 2026!** Last Vision of Fatima artwork explained.
- **New 2026!** A Call to Action to live a Eucharistic life.
- **New 2026!** Several short videos about the Eucharist and St. Carlo Acutis.
- **New 2026!** Some Pop-up talks throughout the exhibit.
- These miracles do include some miracles where the Eucharist turned into actual Flesh and the wine, actual Blood.
