Are you a guard enjoying his job of causing pain and suffering?

Are you someone who will make eye contact with Jesus?

Are you one who looks the other way as you try to get somewhere else?

Are you the one who is following, watching, observing from a distance as you try to decide what to think and do?

Are you someone else?
